

## **RESOLUTION 2006-17**

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SAN BENITO COUNTY WATER DISTRICT SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE PURPOSES OF FIXING THE 2007-2008 SAN FELIPE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM RATES AND CHARGES AND THE ZONE 6 GROUNDWATER CHARGES**

WHEREAS, Section 70 – 7.1 of the San Benito County Water District Act provides that:

“The board shall have the power, in addition to the powers enumerated elsewhere in this act, to levy and collect a ground water charge for the production of water from ground water supplies within a zone or zones of the district which will benefit from the recharge of underground water supplies or the distribution of imported water in such zone or zones; and

WHEREAS, on November 8, 1977 the voters of San Benito County Water District Zone 6 passed Proposition B, which authorized the levy of charges sufficient to repay the United States for the District’s share of the cost of construction and cost of operation and maintenance of the Federal Facilities portion of the San Felipe Division of the Central Valley Project; and

WHEREAS, Proposition B also authorized a levy of charges sufficient to repay the costs of construction and cost of operation and maintenance of the District’s Distribution Facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has authorized notification to property owners of proposed San Felipe Distribution System Rates and Charges and of proposed Zone 6 Groundwater Charges.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Directors of the San Benito County Water District that a public hearing on the matter of San Felipe Distribution System Rates and Charges and Zone 6 Groundwater Charges is to be held on February 20, 2007, at 7:30 pm in the District Office, 30 Mansfield Road, Hollister, California.
